Tournament Structure

- Preregistration must be in by Saturday, February 26, 2011 at the following fee levels:
 - \$35 flat fee per person for kata and/or kumite divisions [to register at the door, \$40 for one event and \$50 for two events].
 - If a competitor preregistered for only kata or only kumite division wishes to add the second division at the door, the fee is \$10.
 - \$30 fee per team, per division, for team kata.
 - Make all checks payable to JKF or Fumio Demura NOT Genbu-Kai.
- Each competitor may enter one individual kata, one individual kumite, and one synchronized team kata.
- Competitors must wear clean white gi.
- If a competitor participates in both kata and kumite, both divisions must be for the same age/rank.
 - Adults 55 and older would spar with adults 40 years and older.
 - Competitors may only compete as either Junior or Adult not both.
- Divisions are determined by kyu rank, not belt color.
- Order and composition of divisions may change at the discretion of officials.
- A minimum of three (3) competitors are required for a division to compete. If there are less than three competitors, the division may be combined with next higher division.
- Awards will be given as follows:
 - Kata medals for first, second, and third place.
 - Kumite medals for first, second, two (2) third place competitors.
 - Team kata medals for first, second, and third place.
- JKF reserves the right to refuse to allow participation to any individual.
- No refunds.

Kumite

- Divisions below Brown Belt will have five (5) referees in the ring, 1 head referee and 4 corner judges; Brown and Black Belts will have four (4) referees in the ring,1 head referee and 3 side judges.
- Divisions below Brown Belt will have two (2) minute matches; Brown and Black Belts will have three (3) minute matches.
- Continuous clock for all divisions, unless head referee instructs timekeeper to go time out.
- Gloves, mouthpiece, and groin protector (males) are required. Gloves will be provided, if needed.
- Coaching of the competitors is **not** allowed individuals who insist on coaching may be ejected from the tournament, without any refund of competition or spectator fees.
- Ties will go into enchosen (sudden death) with no time limit.
 - First point wins.
 - Penalties carry over into enchosen.
- Other than items referenced above, WKF rules apply for all matches with the following exceptions for all divisions below Brown Belt:
 - 1. Divisions below Brown Belt will have three-point matches.
 - 2. All scoring techniques in divisions below Brown Belt will be awarded Ippon.
 - 3. Penalties for divisions below Brown Belt are applied as follows:
 - 1st Chukoku (Warning)
 - 2nd Keikoku (One point penalty)
 - 3rd Hansoku Chui (One point penalty)
 - 4th Hansoku (Disqualification)

Kata

- All kata divisions will have four corner judges plus a head judge.
- Point scoring will be across two full points, 5.0 to 7.0 for beginner divisions, 6.0 to 8.0 for intermediate divisions, and 7.0 to 9.0 for advanced and Black Belt divisions.
- Competitors in the junior beginner divisions (individual kata divisions K0 through K8) are allowed to start their kata over if they forget their place or stop their kata in the middle.
- In case of a tie, each competitor must select a kata different from the one he/she already performed.
- Divisions K0-K8 in case of a tie, competitors may do the same kata over again.

Individual Kata

<u>All Adult and Junior Beginners</u> (7th kyu and under, or less than one year of training) Competitors may choose from the following:

Pinan 1-5, Heian 1-5, Gekisai-Dai-Ichi, Gekisai-Dai-Ni, Tensho, Kanshiwa, Sanchin

All Adult and Junior Intermediate (6th - 4th kyu, or one to two years of training)

Competitors may choose from the following:

Pinan 1-5, Heian 1-5, Gekisai-Dai-Ichi, Gekisai-Dai-Ni, Tensho, Kanshiwa, Sanchin Bassai-Dai, Rohai, Jitte, Jiin, Saifa, Kanshu, Matsukaze

All Adult and Junior Advanced (3rd - 1st kyu, or over two years of training)

Competitors may choose any kata **EXCEPT** (cannot do the following):

Hakutsuru, Sansei-Ru, Shisochin, Tomari-Bassai, Chinshu, Sochin, Unsu, Supar-Rinpei, Nipai-Po, Seisan, Kururunfa, Seipai, Gojushiho, Matsumura-Bassai, Chatanyara-Kusan-Ku.

All Adult and Junior Black Belts Sho Dan and above: Competitors may choose any kata.

Synchronized Team Kata

- Structure of Synchronized Teams any combination of male/female:
 - Junior Divisions all age 17 or under
 - Beginner Division all 4th kyu or lower (beginner and intermediate)
 Advanced Division all 3rd kyu or higher (advanced and Black Belt)
 - Adult Divisions all age 18 or older
 - Beginner Division all 4th kyu or lower (beginner and intermediate)
 - Advanced Division all 3rd kyu or higher (advanced and Black Belt)
- · No Pinan, Heian, or other beginner level katas may be performed in the advanced Junior and Adult Team Kata divisions.
- Any kata performed must be appropriate for the level of the lowest ranked person on the team performing the kata.
- Any formation is acceptable, but kata must begin and end in the same formation.
