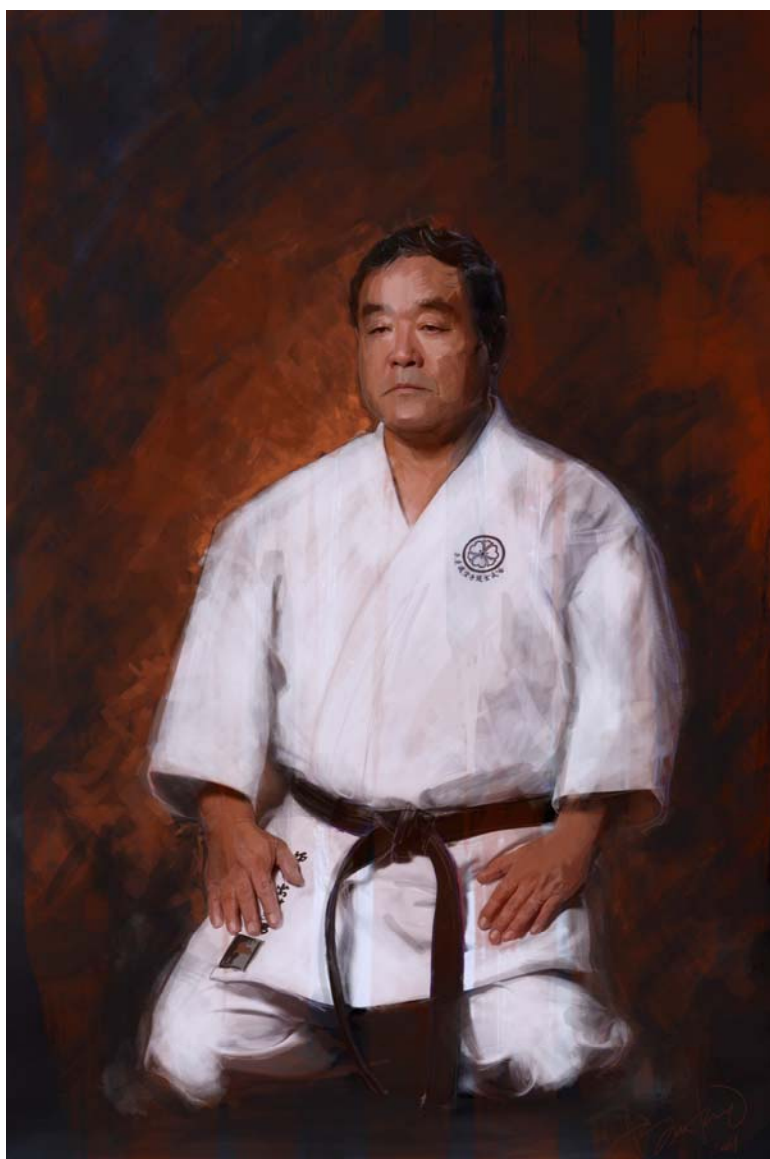

 - Kata only - \$15.00 – EACH COMPETITOR MAY ENTER **ONLY ONE KATA DIVISION.**
 - Kata and cutting - \$40.00.
 - Three Person Team cutting - \$30.00.
- No live (sharp) blades under Black Belt Batto–Do/Iai-Do rank (exceptions with instructor’s approval).
- All blades must pass inspection by tournament officials; **all swords must be at least 24 inches long.**
- All Divisions are Mixed - competitors may be either female or male.
- All Black Belt competitors must wear Hakama (Japanese pants), except beginners.
- All competitors must have either bare feet or wear Tabi (Japanese socks).
- Kata competitors will each do three katas, and will be paired for elimination.
- Cutting competitors and cutting teams will be paired for elimination – see rules for cutting requirements.
